Sally spent 25 years in national security, finishing as Director Cyber Operations, GCHQ, Commander Designate, UK National Cyber Force, and Senior Responsible Officer for the National Offensive Cyber Programme.

Her first public service career spanned technical change, national security and resilience, and crisis management. Operating at the intersection of government, academia, industry and society, Sally built mission led teams across organisations, governing high risk innovation and research, and delivered next generation change through brilliant people.

In 2020 Human Digital Thinking was founded to design and deliver leadership programmes that protects space for authentic, emotionally intelligent, technically articulate leadership and decision making, from law firms to tech giants, and from defence start-ups to the UK construction industry.

Now chair of the British charity Full Fact, Sally is also a non-executive director and strategic adviser to US, Australian and British technology companies, who solve complex societal and organisational challenges around trust, resilience and the partnership between people and technology.
